THE FRANKFORT FORECAST:



Education Senate and House Bills-

HB173- Childhood Protection in Education Act

HB174- A bill to work towards School Choice in Kentucky.

HB470- Prevents minors from receiving gender transition surgeries and hormones.

SB5- Provides procedures to address inappropriate literature in schools and classrooms.

SB115- Prohibits minors from being exposed to sexually-explicit performances.

SB150- Supports a parent's right to know what is happening in schools; Protects teachers from being required to use a student's non-biological pronoun.

Several of these bills have been moving forward and we are tracking them every day!

You can help by calling your Senators and Representatives and telling them you Support these bills. Also, let them know you are praying for them. The left are targeting them hard and even going as far as sending threatening emails.


1. MEMORIAL DAY PARADE
