Turning Point USA's mission is to identify, educate, train, and organize students to promote the principles of fiscal responsibility, free markets, and limited government. Since its founding, Turning Point USA has over 3,500 student-led chapters/clubs on high school and college campuses nationwide.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF A TURNING POINT USA CHAPTER?

The purpose of a Turning Point USA chapter is to educate students about the benefits of limited government, capitalism, free markets, and freedom. Turning Point USA chapters also give like minded students the opportunity to gather and have open discussions about current world events or issues they would like to discuss. WHAT DOES TPUSA PROVIDE TO CHAPTERS?

When a Turning Point USA chapter/club is created, the organization provides the students with a wide range of resources, materials, and opportunities. Below is a list of what Turning Point USA can provide to chapters:

- On campus support for planning, recruitment, and any other help needed from trained Turning Point USA Field Representatives.
- Chapter handbook and online Turning Point USA resources.
- Turning Point USA's National Headquarters will provide materials and resources such as posters, banners, buttons, stickers, sign-up cards, apparel, and much more.
- Turning Point USA provides activism grants for chapters that range from \$100.00 \$5,000.00 for chapter activities.
- The organization provides a wide range of speakers for potential use at chapter led events.
